



LANGHAM PUBLISHING GRANTS

Overview

Dear Friend,

We know that pastors need good books in order to study God's word. Yet we see that the good study texts most helpful for pastors -- books published in the local language and for the local context -- are rare to be found. The *Langham Publishing Grant* program seeks to come alongside Majority World publishing to stimulate the production of study texts for students and pastors which will assist their preaching and teaching.

Our grants focus on places in the world where there is a significant lack of resources available at the student level. Some examples of project grants to date: Chin bible commentary (from translation), Croatian theological dictionary (translation & original material), and Nepalese expositions (original material). Grants require a publishing project to reflect the authority of Scripture, to be evangelical in interpretation and to be serious in theological application. Grants are given for translations or for the development of original manuscripts. Financial support is mainly directed for editorial and 'pre-press' assistance with grant values usually to a maximum of £2000 (\$3500).

Interested organizations and publishers should request an application from the program Administrator, listed below. The completed form will allow applicants to introduce their project to us and begin dialog with the program team. An initial response is made within 90 days and full approval may require up to six months.
